2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §850**, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 764, §19, is
amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 In all other appeals, the costs of the State Board of
7 Property Tax Review in deciding the appeal are divided equally
8 between the parties to the appeal.

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill requires that any costs incurred by the State
14 Board of Property Tax Review in deciding an appeal be paid by the
parties involved in the appeal.
