## An Act to Amend the Certificate of Need Laws to Include Rural Health Clinics.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §303, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1981, c. 705, 4 Pt. V, §5, is further amended to read:

- 7. Health care facility. "Health care facility" means any 6 facility, whether public or private, proprietary or not for profit, required to obtain a certificate of need in accordance 8 with federal--laws--and--regulations--under--the--National--Health Planning-and-Resources-Development-Act-of-1974, or -any-amendment, 10 and-shall-inelude state laws or rules and includes hospitals, psychiatric hospitals, tuberculosis hospitals, skilled nursing 12 facilities, kidney disease treatment centers including free 14 standing free-standing hemodialysis units, intermediate care rehabilitation facilities, facilities, ambulatory surgical 16 facilities, home health care providers and, health maintenance organizations and rural health clinics. The term shall does not apply to any facility operated by religious groups relying solely 18on spiritual means through prayer for healing.
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#### Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §303, sub-§17-B is enacted to read:

17-B. Rural health clinic. "Rural health clinic" means a clinic that is located in rural area designated as a shortage area, is not a rehabilitation agency or a facility primarily for the care and treatment of mental diseases and plans to seek or is seeking Medicaid and Medicare certification and reimbursement as a Rural Health Clinic as described in 42 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 491, Subpart A (1994) and successor regulations. 30

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill modifies the definition of "health care facility" 36 under the Maine Certificate of Need Act of 1978 to include rural health clinics, a term that is also defined in the bill to 38 include certain clinics in rural areas designated as shortage areas. The bill also clarifies that health care facilities under 40 the certificate of need laws are those that must obtain a certificate of need in accordance with state laws and rules.
