One member of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate and one member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 8 Members appointed under this paragraph serve in an advisory 10 capacity only and may not vote; Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §20067, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 410, 12 Pt. LL, $\S12$, is amended to read: 14 1. Oversee and direct office. The commission shall oversee the office in and direct the development and implementation of 16 significant policy matters relating to substance abuse. 18 20 STATEMENT OF FACT 22 This bill makes the legislative members of the Substance Abuse Services Commission advisory only and changes the duties of 24 the commission to include direction of the Office of Substance 2.6 Abuse.
