STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill provides funds for the Maine State Museum to
better serve visitors with disabilities as required by state and
30 federal law, including 2 Museum Technician I educators with
qualifications for sign language interpretation who are required
32 to provide 7-day coverage of educational exhibits. They will
serve school groups and the general public.

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This bill also includes funds for the capital purchase of an
electric mobility device, which will benefit visitors unable to
use standard wheelchairs in the extensively ramped exhibit areas.

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
