12 This amendment replaces the bill.

14 This amendment repeals the duty of the Commissioner of Human a grievance Services to establish procedure concerning 16 discrimination within State Government on the basis of Commissioner currently disability. The of Education is responsible for administering the Rehabilitation Act. 18 This amendment adds to that responsibility the duty to establish, by 20 rule, a grievance procedure to handle claims of discrimination based on disability. It contains the new references to the Code Regulations adopted the Americans with 22 of Federal since Disabilities Act was enacted. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill. 24
