Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §42-B, as amended by PL 1989, c. 502, Pt. A, 4 §64, is further amended to read:

- 6 §42-B. Adoption of a grievance procedure concerning discrimination on the basis of disability
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The commissioner shall adopt rules pursuant to the Maine 10 Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II, to create a grievance procedure applicable to all bodies of 12 State Government in accordance with 45 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 84.7 and with 28 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 35.107(b). To the extent that a grievance 14procedure adopted under this section conflicts with a grievance procedure otherwise adopted by a state agency to comply with 45 16 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 84.7, the procedure adopted under this section shall--control controls, except in cases of 18 conflict with other federal regulations. 20
