COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 943, L.D. 1332, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Town of Topsham to Increase the Amount the Town May Contribute to the Construction Costs of Sewers That Belong or May Later Belong to the Topsham Sewer District"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1957, c. 128, §13, as enacted by P&SL 1963, c. 49, §3, is amended to read:

Sec. 13. Town of Topsham authorized to contribute to construction costs. ~~The Town of Topsham may from time to time contribute to the expense of funds to pay for some or all of the expenses associated with the construction and or reconstruction of the sewers belonging to of the Topsham Sewer District up to but not exceeding 1/2 the costs of such construction by so voting at any annual or special town meeting. Said The town may raise money for such these purposes in whole or part by any lawful means, including, but not limited to, by taxation or may issue, by issuance of its notes for the payment of its share in whole or part or may issue by issuance of its bonds under the Maine Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 53, Title 30-A, section 137 for the payment of the share in whole or part 5111.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the language of the bill and specifies that the Town of Topsham may, by any lawful means, raise money to assist the Topsham Sewer District in the construction or reconstruction of sewers.
