SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 954, L.D. 1343, "Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the Trespass Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 2nd section 5 (page 2, lines 36 to 50 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Costs paid by department. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall reimburse the Legislature for expenses of the commission upon request by the Executive Director of the Legislative Council.'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates the need for a General Fund appropriation to the Legislature.

The additional costs to reimburse the Legislature for the expenses of the Commission to Study the Trespass Laws can be absorbed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing budgeted resources.
