An Act to Clarify Animal Welfare Laws Relating to Euthanasia by Owners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §4011, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 383, §3, is repealed: 4 6 1. Cruelty to animals. A person, including an owner or the owner's agent, is guilty of cruelty to animals if that person: 8 A. Kills or attempts to kill an animal belonging to another 10 person without the consent of the owner or without legal privilege. A person, including an owner or the owner's agent, may not kill or attempt to kill an animal by a method 12 that causes undue suffering. If a person, including an 14 owner or the owner's agent, kills or attempts to kill an animal by a method that causes undue suffering or that does 16 not cause instantaneous death, that person is guilty of cruelty to animals. The owner or occupant of property may 18 use reasonable force that does not cause undue suffering to eject a trespassing animal; 20 B. Injures, overworks, tortures, torments, abandons, gives 22 poison, drugs or alcohol to, cruelly beats or mutilates an animal or exposes a poison with the intent that it be taken 24 by an animal; 26 C. Deprives an animal that the person owns or possesses of necessary sustenance, necessary medical attention, proper 28 shelter, protection from the weather or humanely clean conditions; or 30 D. Keeps or leaves a domestic animal on an uninhabited or 32 barren island lying off the coast of Maine during the month of December, January, February or March without providing 34 necessary sustenance and proper shelter. A person, including an owner or the owner's agent, is guilty of cruelty to animals if that person kills or attempts to kill a cat or dog: 40 A.
