24	STATEMENT OF FACT
26	This bill provides for conditional administrator
	certification for an administrator who is otherwise qualified for
28	full certification but may lack completion in one or more of the
	competency areas. Conditional certification requires a specific
30	time for the individual to complete requirements for full
	certification. The purpose of this bill is to expand the pool of
32	qualified administrators to fill job vacancies.
