	'6. Budgets. The board shall submit to the commissioner
24	its budgetary requirements. The board shall develop a biennial budget. For its first 5 years, annual expenditures may not
26	exceed \$50,000 for the first year, \$120,000 for the 2nd year, \$123,000 for the 3rd year, \$127,000 for the 4th year and \$131,000
28	for the 5th year.
30	At a minimum, the budget must include the following information:
32	A. The expenditures the board intends to make in the
34	following year, broken down by type and amount of expenditure; and
36	B. The receipts the board expects to receive in the
38	following year, broken down by the type and the amount of the receipt.
40	The board shall hold public hearings, pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act and hear public comment with respect

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in that part designated "\$14812." in the 2nd paragraph in last 2 lines (page 10, lines 28 and 29 in amendment) by striking out the following:

18 "same purposes in the following fiscal years" and inserting in its place the following: 'purpose of reducing fees imposed on licensees'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by striking out all of the 2nd part designated "\$14816." (page 11, lines 44 to 46 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

#### '§14817. Legislative review; repeal

This Act is repealed April 1, 1996. The board shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters the extent to which the board and the industry at large, as regulated by the board, have developed regulations and methods of communication between the board and licensees, including, but not limited to, communication on all matters relating to the receipt and expenditure of funds, sufficient to ensure public health and safety and address the issue of whether some or all portions of the board's activities may be privatized.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 6 and 7 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 6. Working capital advance. The State Controller is authorized to advance to the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation up to \$50,000 from the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus in fiscal year 1995-96 for the licensure of installers of propane and natural gas equipment. These funds will be used to provide the working capital advance necessary to fund the costs of the licensure of installers of propane and natural gas equipment until adequate dedicated revenues have been received. Funds advanced for this purpose must be returned to
