	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §12408, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1993, c. 35, §1, is further amended to read:
6	3. Current practitioners. Persons who were practicing acupuncture in the State as of August-9,-1989, January 1, 1996
8	and meet either group of qualifications listed in this section shall-be are eligible if they are at least 21 years old. The
LO	qualification groups are:
12	A. Experienced-based group. The requirements for the experienced-based group are:
L4 L6	(1) A minimum of 2 1/2 years of practicing acupuncture in the State as of August-9,-1989 January 1, 1996;
L8 20	(2) A minimum of 1,000 hours of classroom instruction in acupuncture and related subjects at an institute approved by the board; and
40	approved by the board, and
22	(3) A minimum of 300 hours of clinical experience in acupuncture; and
24	B. Test-based group. The requirements for the test-based
26	group are:
