S	3918. Issuance of vaccination certificate
v	A person who has successfully completed instruction approved y the department and is certified by the department may accinate a dog that resides in a kennel licensed under sections 923-C, 3931-A and 3932 and issue a vaccination certificate.
S	3919. Vaccinations
<u>y</u> <u>y</u>	Within 6 months of receiving an application, the ommissioner shall make available approved instruction in rabies accinations at a location within 150 miles of the applicant. The applicant shall indicate the kennel where the applicant will accinate and the commissioner shall maintain a file of this information.
5	Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §3923-B, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 468, 12, is amended to read:
3 5 6	2. Rabies tags. An owner shall make sure that a rabies tag betained from a veterinarian or a kennel licensed under sections 1923-C, 3931-A and 3932 for immunization against rabies is securely attached to a collar of leather, metal or material of comparable strength and that the collar is worn at all times by the dog for which the rabies tag was issued, except as provided in subsection 3.
	Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §3936, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
<u>t</u>	1-A. Certified personnel. Prior to an inspection, the department shall determine from its records whether personnel of the kennel, boarding kennel or breeding kennel are certified to
	vaccinate for rabies and include a review of the vaccination procedures in its inspection.
	STATEMENT OF FACT
1	This bill allows a person who has successfully completed instruction approved by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to administer rabies vaccinations to dogs that reside in a licensed kennel.
