Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6162-A, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 876, §§4 and 10, is amended to read:

2. Income. Eligibility for this program shall--be is determined by the same income levels as eligibility for elderly households is determined under chapter 907, except that individuals are also eligible for this program if the household spends at least 40% of its income on health care and the household income is not more than 25% higher than the levels specified in chapter 907.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill expands eligibility for the elderly low-cost drug program to include individuals when at least 40% of the household income is spent on health care and the household income is not more than 25% above current normal levels.
