HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 975, L.D. 1384, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Efficiency of Cumberland County Government Operations"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 2 indented paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 23 to 32 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in the 3rd indented paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Further amend" and inserting in its place the following: "Amend"

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 and 2.

Further amend the amendment in section 9 by striking out all of the indented paragraph (page 4, lines 2 to 12 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates those provisions that represent state mandates.
