## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the patient or the examining physician, certified nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife to obtain a referral from the patient's primary care physician if further treatment is needed and the carrier requires that referral.

This amendment allows a carrier to require a physician, certified nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife to inform a woman's primary care physician prior to rendering gynecological services.

This amendment also specifies that all group plans must provide coverage for annual gynecological examinations performed by a certified nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife.
