28	law to the contrary, this Act applies to all civil actions, timely claims or claims declared to be timely under the 6th
30	Amended and Restated Disclosure Statement filed pursuant to Section 1125 of the Federal Bankruptcy Code in re: A.H. Robins
32	<u>Company, Inc.</u> , dated March 28, 1988, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of Virginia (case number 85-01307-R) that were
34	filed prior to March 1, 1995, whether or not they are pending, regardless of when any such action or claim accrued and
36	regardless of whether the claim has lapsed or otherwise is barred by any other statute of limitations, and revives any action
38	previously dismissed solely on the ground of limitations.
40	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

44	'FISCAL NOTE
46	This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative
48	costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can
