SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 989, L.D. 1397, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Laws Affecting the Department of Environmental Protection"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1661-D is enacted to read:


§1661-D. Reformulated gasoline

Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, all gasoline sold or delivered in this State must be reformulated gasoline. For purposes of this section, "reformulated gasoline" means gasoline described in Section 211(k) of the federal Clean Air Act, as amended, 42 United States Code, Section 7545(k).'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that all gasoline sold or delivered in this State be reformulated gasoline.
