2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§2-A** is enacted to read:

6 **2-A. Political signs.** Signs bearing political messages
8 relating to an election, primary or referendum and those devices
10 used to hold the signs in the ground must be biodegradable and
12 nonmetallic.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill requires that political signs and those devices
used to hold the signs in the ground be biodegradable and
nonmetallic.
