Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7901, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 252,
4	§2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	2. Class D crimes. Violation of any of the following is a Class D crime for which the convicted person must be imprisoned
8	for not less than 3 days for the first offense and for not less than 10 days for each succeeding offense, this imprisonment not
10	to be suspended, and for which a convicted person must be fined not less than \$1,000 and this fine may not be suspended:
