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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1001, L.D. 1412, Bill, "An Act to Make Additional Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1995"

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Amend the bill in Part D in section 5 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 23, lines 32 to 35 in L.D.)

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FISCAL NOTE

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The effect of this amendment on the ability of the Productivity Realization Task Force to realize the savings proposed in the Governor's proposed current services budget can not be determined at this time.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment removes the language that conflicts with the current state employee collective bargaining agreements. Employees in positions transferred as a result of the implementation of the recommendations of the Productivity Realization Task Force would maintain their basic contractual rights. The amendment would not restrict the administration's ability to achieve the targeted savings in Part D, section 1 of the bill.

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
