

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §183-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§183-A. Air lift medical services**

8 The Maine Army National Guard shall maintain a 24-hour,  
10 on-call helicopter airlift service to provide air service at the  
request of any hospital or municipal official for use in any  
medical emergency throughout the State.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 **This bill directs the Maine Army National Guard to maintain**  
16 **a 24-hour, on-call helicopter airlift service for medical**  
**emergencies throughout the State.**
