HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1008, L.D. 1419, Bill, "An Act to Modify the Licensure Act for Substance Abuse Counselors"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 3 indented paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 12 in subsection 12 in the last line (page 5, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the rules of the board" and inserting in its place the following: 'or equivalent qualifications as determined by the board by rulemaking' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restores the language regarding clinical supervision to that as proposed in the original bill with the exception that the State Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors may establish equivalent qualifications for certification.
