STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment adds a statement affirming that the State's goal is to maintain and restore water quality and to eliminate or control combined sewer overflows as soon as practicable. The amendment also clarifies that the Board of Environmental Protection is not required to create a CSO subcategory when the stated conditions are met, but the board has discretion to do so. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
