COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1028, L.D. 1443

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with providing periodic 6 information on federal mandates to the Bureau of the Budget can 8 be absorbed by state departments and agencies utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Bureau of the Budget will incur some minor additional costs to compile the federal mandate information and annually 12 report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.' 14

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill. The amendment 20 requires every agency and department of the State to submit to the State Budget Officer a list of any new laws, new regulations or other actions that may require the State to comply with any 2.2 federal mandate. The State Budget Officer is required to provide 24 a compiled list of new federal mandates to the Legislature by January 1st of each year. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
