Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1101, sub-§6, as amended by PL 1987, c. 735, §46, is further amended to read:

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the definition of "master electrician" by removing references to firms or corporations and clarifies that it is an individual that is qualified. Currently, a master electrician includes a person, firm or corporation. This has been interpreted to require that each entity needs to be licensed, which has resulted in license duplication, as an electrician in a firm needs a license, as well as the firm.
