COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1047, L.D. 1466, Bill, "An Act to Create an Adopt-A-River Program"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§573.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§573.~~" in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§573.~~" in subsection 5 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§573.~~" in subsection 6 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§573.~~" by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'7. Coordination. In administering the program, the Bureau of Parks and Recreation may coordinate efforts with local governments, including counties, and with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.'

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This amendment make administration of the program optional
for the Bureau of Parks and Recreation, removes the annual
22 reporting requirement and specifies that the Bureau of Parks and
Recreation may cooperate with local units of government and with
24 the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
