26	The additional costs to monitor schools' compliance with certain federal regulations can be absorbed by the Department of

36	STATEMENT OF FACT
38	This amendment adds new definitions of "deaf" and "hard of hearing" to the bill. The amendment changes the number of
40	members serving on the advisory council to the Division of

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Deafness from 23 to 24 and removes the nonvoting status from members-at-large. The amendment also eliminates a provision

concerning federal impact aid, which is addressed in separate

legislation, and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
