	Sec. 1. Rest areas opened to commercial trucks. Resolved: That
2	the Department of Transportation and the Maine Turnpike Authority
	shall reopen any rest area or weigh station that is closed to the
4	public on the interstate or Maine Turnpike on the effective date
	of this resolve. The reopened rest areas must be maintained and
6	repaired by the entity that controls the area. Any rest area
	opened pursuant to this resolve may be used only by commercial
8	trucks, truck tractors, trailers and semitrailers. Use of a rest
	area opened pursuant to this resolve by any other vehicle is
10	prohibited except state vehicles, those authorized by the entity
	in charge of the rest area and those necessary for maintenance
12	and repair.
