20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1057, L.D. 1486, Bill, "An
Act to Add Types of Pharmacies That Are Subject to Record Seizure"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If
a jail sentence is imposed for a Class E crime, the additional
costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.22 per day per
prisoner. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The
number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the
resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be
insignificant.

The additional workload and administrative costs associated
with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system
can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
Department. The collection of additional fines may increase
dedicated revenue to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession
of Pharmacy by minor amounts.'
