

**An Act to Prohibit Retirement Contributions by Employees of
Agricultural Commodity Groups from Being Applied towards the
Unfunded Liability of the Maine State Retirement System.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17151, sub-§2, ¶D** is enacted to read:

6 D. Beginning in fiscal year 1995-96, the retirement
8 contributions of a person who is employed by an agricultural
10 commodity group and who is paid entirely from Other Special
12 Revenue funds may not be applied towards the unfunded
14 liability of the retirement system.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill prohibits retirement contributions by agricultural
16 commodity group employees who are paid entirely from Other
18 Special Revenue funds from being applied towards the unfunded
liability of the Maine State Retirement System. This provision
takes effect beginning in fiscal year 1995-96.

20 This bill implements one of the recommendations of the
Commission to Study Potato Quality Issues.
