HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 548, L.D. 1496, Bill, "An Act to Improve the AFDC Program"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 7 in that part designated "~~§3741-C.~~" by inserting at the end the following:

'4. Home visit. The department shall implement a home visit program in Regions II, IV and V, as defined in section 6-A, under which the department shall visit the homes of all persons determined to be eligible for Aid to Families with Dependent Children for the following purposes:

A. To complete the family contract required by section 3741-J;

B. To reinforce the reporting responsibilities of the family, including child support enforcement;

C. To verify information provided at the time of application, including checking social security numbers; and

D. To request and receive any additional information.'

FISCAL NOTE

Requiring home visits in certain regions will increase the General Fund cost of establishing eligibility by over \$100,000, annually.
