16	to Increase Access to Primary Care Physician Services in Maine"
18	Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 2-A and inserting in its place the following:
20	'2-A. Joint-program resident, An applicant who is enrolled
22	in a program of medical and graduate medical training conducted jointly by a medical school accredited by the Liaison Committee
24	on Medical Education and a graduate medical education program approved by the Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical
26	Education may receive a temporary educational certificate from the board to act as a hospital resident as part of that graduate
28	medical education program if the applicant is concurrently enrolled in the final year of medical training and the initial
30	year of graduate medical education. The board may not issue a certificate pursuant to this subsection for a period longer than
. 32	that required to obtain the M.D. degree. The period during which the certificate is in force may not be considered in determining
34	satisfaction of the requirement for postgraduate medical education under section 3271, subsection 2.'
