HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1075, L.D. 1514, "Resolve, Establishing the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph on page 2 (page 2, lines 1 to 3 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 3 lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Four members of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs, 2 members appointed by the President of the Senate and 2 members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and'

This amendment changes the appointing authority of the 4 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs from the chairs of the committee to 2 by the President of the Senate and 2 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
