SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1075, L.D. 1514, "Resolve, Establishing the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 7th indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the last 2 lines (page 3, lines 41 and 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "expenses; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: 'expenses.'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 8.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations will incur additional costs to provide staff assistance to the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales and to reimburse legislative and private members for their per diem and expenses. These costs can be absorbed by the bureau within existing budgeted resources.

The additional costs to provide legal assistance to the task force can be absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
