COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1075, L.D. 1514, "Resolve, Establishing the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "stores;" the following: 'and'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 2, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the first line (page 2, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "C." and inserting in its place the following: 'B.'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "9" and inserting in its place the following: '11'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2, lines 41 to 43 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. A state employee who currently works in a state-operated liquor store, selected by the state liquor store employees through their bargaining agent;'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 6 in the first line (page 3, line 1 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Two" and inserting in its place the following: 'Four'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

General Fund (\$17,200)

This resolve includes an allocation from the Alcoholic Beverage Fund of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96 for the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations for the related expenses of the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales. This allocation will result in a corresponding decrease in General Fund revenue of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96.

The additional costs to provide legal assistance to the task force can be absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Administrative and Financial Services will incur some minor additional costs to provide staff assistance to the task force. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes the language that requires the study task force to specifically study a 3rd discount liquor store in Bangor and increases the membership of the study task force from 9 to 11. The increase is accomplished by replacing the membership of the Director of the Division of Financial and Personnel Services of the Department of Administrative and Financial Services with a member who is a state employee currently working at a state-operated liquor store and by increasing the number of members from the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs from 2 to 4. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
