This resolve includes an allocation from the Alcoholic Beverage Fund of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96 for the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations for the related expenses of the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales. allocation will result in a corresponding decrease in General Fund revenue of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96.

The additional costs to provide legal assistance to the task force can be absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Administrative and Financial Services will incur some minor additional costs to provide staff assistance to the task force. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes the language that requires the study task force to specifically study a 3rd discount liquor store in Bangor and increases the membership of the study task force from 42 The increase is accomplished by replacing the 9 to 11. membership of the Director of the Division of Financial and Personnel Services of the Department of Administrative Financial Services with a member who is a state employee currently working at a state-operated liquor store and by 48 increasing the number of members from the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs from 2 to 4. 50 amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
