This bill includes an allocation from the Alcoholic Beverage 48 Fund of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96 for the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations for the related 50 expenses of the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales. This allocation will result in a corresponding decrease in General 52 Fund revenue of \$17,200 in fiscal year 1995-96.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "p" to H.P. 1075, L.D. 1514

The additional costs to provide legal assistance to the task force can be absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General
 utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Administrative and Financial Services will incur some minor additional costs to provide staff assistance to the task force. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This amendment is the minority report. It removes the language that requires the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales to specifically study a 3rd discount liquor store in Bangor and increases the membership of the study task force from 9 to 15.
18 The increase is accomplished by:

 Replacing the membership of the Director of the Division of Financial and Personnel Services of the Department of Administrative and Financial Services with a member who is a state employee currently working at a state-operated liquor store;

Increasing the number of members from the Joint Standing
 Committee on Legal and Veterans' Affairs from 2 to 4;

28 3. Adding a member from a nonprofit social service organization with a long history of interest and active 30 participation in alcohol-related matters; and

32 4. Adding 3 members who represent 3 business organizations that have a direct interest in the alcohol business.
