HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1087, L.D. 1532, Bill, "An Act Requiring Doctors of Naturopathic Medicine to Be Licensed by the Naturopathic Board of Examiners and Regulating Naturopathic Health Care Practice"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 4th line (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "license" and inserting in its place the following: 'regulate'


Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Qualifications for licensure, certification or registration;'

This amendment corrects Committee Amendment "A" to clarify that the Task Force on Naturopathy is charged with determining the method by which the State should regulate naturopaths. The method of regulation may include forms of licensure, certification or registration.
