COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1090, L.D. 1534, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Board of Licensure of Water Treatment Plant Operators"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§2624-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "employed by a water utility"

Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "~~§2629.~~" in the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (page 4, lines 35 and 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~The application fee shall not exceed \$35, and the biennial renewal fee shall not exceed \$30.~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'The application fee shall may not exceed \$35, and the biennial renewal fee shall may not exceed \$30.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs to reimburse board members for expenses can be absorbed by the Department of Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the requirement that the public member of the Board of Licensure of Water Treatment Plant Operators who is a registered professional engineer be employed
