HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1095, L.D. 1539, Bill, "An Act to Permit a One-time Transfer of Uncommitted Funds for Community Corrections Programs"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6-A by striking out the last blocked paragraph (page 3, lines 6 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All funds not committed under this subsection by March 31, 1995 must be distributed during fiscal year 1995-96 by the department to the counties proportionally based on the average daily population of each county jail during the calendar year 1994 resulting from sentences imposed under Title 17-A, section 1203, subsection 1, paragraph B and Title 17-A, section 1252, subsection 1, paragraph B.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment permits a one-time transfer of uncommitted funds for community corrections programs to support county jail operations costs. Pursuant to the amendment, the amount each county receives is based on the average daily population of its county jail during the calendar year 1994 resulting from sentences imposed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 1203, subsection 1, paragraph B and Title 17-A, section 1252, subsection 1, paragraph B.
