HOUSE AMENDMENT 'C' to H.P. 1095, L.D. 1539, Bill, "An Act to Permit a One-time Transfer of Uncommitted Funds for Community Corrections Programs"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Permit a One-time Transfer of Retained Funds for Community Corrections Programs'

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 4th "Whereas," paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "uncommitted" and inserting in its place the following: 'retained'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6-A in the blocked paragraph in the 2nd line (page 3, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the counties all funds that have not been committed by March 31," and inserting in its place the following: 'the counties all retained funds that are committed or uncommitted by June 30,'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the one-time distribution from approximately \$610,800 to approximately \$1,094,500 in fiscal year 1995-96. The funds have already been appropriated to the Department of Corrections.


