SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1103, L.D. 1550

The bill will increase dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Trust Fund by \$340,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96. In addition, because this bill is an emergency, the fund will also realize additional dedicated revenues of \$10,027 for fiscal year 1994-95.

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Additional annual allocations of the new dedicated revenue are included based on the following distributions: the Maine State Parks Fund within the Department of Conservation will receive an additional \$159,017 and \$204,000 and the Maine Endangered and Nongame Wildlife Fund within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will receive an additional \$106,010 and \$136,000 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively. The allocation amounts differ from the revenue estimates due to the lag in the transfer of this dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Trust Fund.'
