Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §153, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1993, c. 675,
4 Pt. B, §1, is further amended to read:

3. Western Aroostook. Western Aroostook consists of the
municipalities and unorganized territory known as Hamlin Plt.,
8 Cyr Plt., T17 R3, T17 R4, T16 R5, T15 R6, Winterville Plt., T15
R8, T15 R9, T14 R10, T14 R11, T14 R12, T14 R13, T14 R14, T14 R15,
10 T14 R16, and all municipalities and unorganized territory in
Aroostook County lying to the west and north of these. The
12 District Court for Western Aroostook must be held at Madawaska,
and Fort Kent ~~and Van Buren~~. The Chief Judge shall determine the
14 level of service at each location.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill removes Van Buren as a site at which the Western
20 Aroostook District Court must be held.
