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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment amends the provision on consideration of hospital financial requirements. During any time that payments to hospitals are made under the federal disproportionate share to hospitals formula, it requires the Maine Health Care Finance Commission to exclude the cost of services provided to involuntarily committed patients. It adds a fiscal note to the bill.
