SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1137, L.D. 1580, "Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Kennebec County for the Year 1995"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$4,525,860" and inserting in its place the following: '\$4,553,610'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 3. Summary. Resolved: That the figures appearing in this resolve represent the total amount of taxes and the total specific expenditures authorized for the calendar year 1995. The following is a summary of revenues and appropriations:

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment increases the county tax assessment by an additional \$27,750 by decreasing the amount of available credits that offset this assessment.
