This bill offsets additional General Fund appropriations of \$15,000,000 annually in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97 through statewide deappropriations of \$15,000,000 annually in those same fiscal years. Departments and agencies statewide will need to cover these deappropriations by generating \$15,000,000 18 . additional budget reductions each year in certain "targeted" All Other and Capital Expenditures line category savings.''

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment strikes the text of the committee amendment and replaces it with the following. This amendment eliminates the issuance of \$34,000,000 in special obligation bonds of the Maine the Department Turnpike Authority for of Transportation projects. This amendment funds the current Transportation Investment Program backlog by utilizing \$30,000,000 in General Fund allotment reserve savings as well as approximately \$4,000,000 in additional Highway Fund productivity savings in fiscal year 1996-97. The amendment restores the State Police funding ratio to 50% General Fund and 50% Highway Fund.
