This amendment includes General Fund appropriations of 24 \$21,501 and \$41,950 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for the Department of Conservation to restore 26 funding for one Forester I position. The amendment offsets these additional appropriations through an increase in the statewide 28 deappropriations for salary savings generated from attrition by \$21,501 and \$41,950 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, 30 respectively.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restores General Fund appropriations for one 36 Forester I position in the Department of Conservation and adjusts projected General Fund salary savings in Part J of the bill. 38
