SENATE AMENDMENT " E " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1150, L.D. 1589, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Productivity Realization Task Force"

Amend the amendment on page 94 by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part J in section 4 in that part designated "ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the 5th line (page 176, line 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Personal Services (\$1,097,007) (\$1,672,390)''

Further amend the amendment on page 94 by inserting after Part L, section 2 the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART M

Sec. M-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.



deappropriations for salary savings generated from attrition by
