24	Sec. M-1. State employee participation in Productivity Realization
26	<b>Task Force study.</b> In accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 2, a state employee may not be impeded or
28	prevented from contributing to or participating in the study conducted by the Productivity Realization Task Force established
30	in Public Law 1995, chapter 99. An employee of this State, as that term is defined in Title 5, section 20, subsection 1, or
32	appointed executive employee, as that term is defined in Title 5, section 19, subsection 1, paragraph A, may not issue or
34	promulgate any policy that contravenes this section.'
36	Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
38	consecutively.
